

Quail Creek Billiard Club (QCBC) Member Rules of Conduct in the Billiard Room

Billiard Club Members are to adhere to the following rules in the Billiard Room:

- 1. QCBC Members inter-personal behavior, including verbal and physical expressions, and actions, shall be conducted in a manner that is courteous and respectful of other club members and guests.**
- 2. QCBC Member conversations shall be free of prejudice, defamatory expressions or negative implications towards club members, or others in the Billiards Room.**
- 3. Incidents regarding violation of these rules shall be settled promptly with the persons directly involved so as to preclude the need for involvement by others.**
- 4. Disagreements or disputes about an incident that are not resolved, as above, shall be directed to the QCBC President. He or she will then determine if resolution is possible with his or her assistance, or alternatively, refer the issue to the QCBC Board of Directors.**

It should be noted that every QCBC member has the right to openly express their questions and opinions without fear of retribution or verbal attack, but must conduct themselves in an orderly fashion, compliant with the above rules of conduct.

Failure to follow these rules of Billiards Room behavior will be dealt with and corrected. Continued failure may result in QCBC Board action.
